Solve the following word problems.

- 1 John bought a winter jacket for \$78.75. How much money is left if he had \$100 to start with?

- 2 A store was selling winter boots for \$90.50. During a winter sale, the price dropped by \$45.25. What is the new price of the boots?

- 3 Emma had 12.5 gallons of anti-freeze. She used 3.75 gallons to winterize her car. How many gallons of anti-freeze does she have left?

- 4 The first ski slope was 14.88 miles long, and the second slope measured 9.37 miles. What was the difference in length between the two slopes?

- 5 A ski resort charges \$80.50 for a day pass. If you have a discount coupon of \$25.25, how much will you have to pay?

- 6 A family used 75.50 pounds of firewood on Saturday and 55.25 pounds on Sunday. How much less firewood did they use on Sunday?

- 7 A snowplow cleared 18.75 miles of road in the morning and 15.50 miles in the afternoon. How many fewer miles did it clear in the afternoon?

- 8 A store sold 65.50 pounds of salt on Monday and 42.75 pounds on Tuesday. How much less salt did the store sell on Tuesday?
