Solve the following word problems.

- 1 Sarah collected 10 seashells at the beach, but she gave 3 to her friend. How many seashells does Sarah have left?

- 2 John had 10 ice cream cones, but he ate 4. How many ice cream cones does John have left?

- 3 There were 10 kids at the summer camp, but 2 went home early. How many kids are left at the camp?

- 4 A tree had 10 apples, but 5 fell off. How many apples are left on the tree?

- 5 Lily caught 10 fireflies, but 7 flew away. How many fireflies does Lily have left?

- 6 Tom had 10 water balloons, but 6 burst. How many water balloons does Tom have left?

- 7 A picnic had 10 sandwiches, but 3 were eaten. How many sandwiches are left at the picnic?

- 8 There were 10 sunflowers in the garden, but 4 were picked. How many sunflowers are left in the garden?

- 9 A lemonade stand had 10 cups of lemonade, but 2 were sold. How many cups of lemonade are left?
