

# Winter Subtraction

Solve the following word problems.

1 A group of friends built 8 snow forts. 2 of the forts collapsed. How many snow forts are still standing?

2 Sara has 8 winter hats. She gives 4 to her friend. How many hats does she have now?

---

3 There were 10 snowflakes on the window. 4 melted away. How many snowflakes are left on the window?

---

4 A snowman had 8 buttons, but 3 fell off. How many buttons are still on the snowman?

---

5 There were 7 icicles hanging from the roof. 5 fell down. How many icicles are left?

---

6 Billy had 10 candy canes. He ate 3. How many candy canes does Billy have left?

---

7 There are 9 snowmen in the park. Some kids knock down 2 of them. How many snowmen are left standing?

---

8 There are 10 Christmas lights on the tree. 2 of them go out. How many lights are still shining?

---

9 There were 9 penguins on the ice. 5 slid into the water. How many penguins are left on the ice?

---

10 Tom had 8 pairs of winter socks. He lost 2 pairs. How many pairs of socks does Tom have left?
