

## **Cooking Subtraction**

Solve the following word problems.

- 1 Sarah baked a cake that weighed 80 ounces. After her family ate some, it weighed 45 ounces. How many ounces of cake did her family eat?
- 2 John bought 90 pounds of flour. He used 30 pounds to bake bread. How many pounds of flour does he have left?
- 3 Emily made 60 cups of lemonade. She sold 45 cups at a lemonade stand. How many cups of lemonade does she have left?
- 4 Mike made 70 ounces of pasta. After dinner, there were 25 ounces left. How many ounces of pasta did his family eat?
- 5 Susan bought 100 pounds of sugar. She used 75 pounds to make cookies. How many pounds of sugar does she have left?
- 6 David made 80 pints of soup. He served 35 pints at a party. How many pints of soup does he have left?
- 7 Jennifer made 90 cups of iced tea. She served 50 cups at a picnic. How many cups of iced tea does she have left?
- 8 Sam baked a pie that weighed 70 ounces. After his friends ate some, it weighed 40 ounces. How many ounces of pie did his friends eat?
