- 1 John has 1,000 miles to travel to reach his destination. After driving for 300 miles, how many miles does he still have to travel?
- 2 Sarah had 1,000 dollars for her vacation. She spent 450 dollars on her flight ticket. How much money does she have left?
- 3 A cruise ship traveled 900 miles to an island. On the return trip, it traveled 250 miles less. How many miles did the ship travel in the return trip?
- A tourist had 1,000 pictures on his camera. He deleted 375 pictures. How many pictures are left on his camera?
- 5 A traveler had a budget of 1,000 dollars for his trip. He spent 275 dollars on food and 350 dollars on accommodation. How much money does he have left?
- 6 A cruise ship has a capacity of 1,000 passengers. Currently, there are 725 passengers on board. How many more passengers can the ship take?
- 7 A hiker has a water bottle with a capacity of 1,000 milliliters. He drank 600 milliliters of water. How much water is left in his bottle?
- 8 A cruise ship has a capacity of 1,000 passengers. If 890 passengers have already boarded, how many more passengers can the ship accommodate?
