- There were 5 birds on a tree. 3 flew away. How many birds are left on the tree?
- 5 Lucy had 3 popsicles. She ate 1. How many popsicles does Lucy have left?
- There were 5 sandcastles on the beach. The wave washed away 2. How many sandcastles are left?
- 7 Tommy caught 4 fireflies. He let 2 go. How many fireflies does Tommy have now?
- There were 5 boats on the lake. 1 sailed away. How many boats are left on the lake?
- 9 Sara had 5 water balloons. She threw 2 at her friend. How many water balloons does Sara have left?
- There were 3 fish in the pond. 2 swam away. How many fish are left in the pond?
