

# Let's Go Camping!

Solve the problems based on volume cubes and cuboids.

You have a rectangular box to pack your tent. The box has a length of 6 feet, a width of 4 feet, and a height of 2 feet.  
What is the volume of the box?

You need to pack two sleeping bags in a cube-shaped box. Each side of the box measures 3 feet.  
What is the volume of the box?

Your food supplies are packed in a rectangular container with a length of 4 feet, a width of 3 feet, and a height of 2 feet.  
What is the volume of the container?

The camping gear is packed in a cuboid box with dimensions of 7 feet by 3 feet by 3 feet. Calculate the volume of the box.
